


## TERRES DE L'EBRE

"You name it, here you have it" seems to be the case in these lands, and make them quite exceptional if not unique.

It is the case of the Terres de l'Ebre; a declared UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, here is a natural mosaic of gastronomy, culture and landscape, laid out between the Mediterranean Sea and the southernmost part of the Catalan pre-coastal mountain range.

An extensive network of cycling itineraries allows you to tour this relatively small territory, which offers a landscape of spectacular natural beauty, located far enough away from the agglomerations of conventional tourist circuits.





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## ITINERARIES TO GET TO KNOW BAIX EBRE – TERRES DE L'EBRE

Cycletourism is a relaxing way to discover Terres de l'Ebre and its varied scenery. The converted train track Greenway La Val de Zafán which goes through Terra Alta to Tortosa is ideal for families and groups of friends to cycle along together, taking in the scenery on the way. The same can be said for various stages of the The Ebro Nature Trail. In fact, the bicycle will take the visitor to some of the most out-of-the-way spots on the Delta Ebro Nature Reserve. Here lanes lead to quiet beaches past lagoons and fields of rice.

To sum up, **Baix Ebre region and the whole area of Terres del Ebre has a network of more than 1.000 kilometres** of lanes and quiet country roads apart from the Greenway: more than 130 kilometres and completely free of traffic. The most mountainous areas of these regions also have a good network of routes for nature lovers and mountain bikers with paths that go through mountain ranges, ridges, olive groves and quiet villages full of history.


One of the great things about the lanes, trails and cycleways in Terres de l'Ebre is that they link the two nature reserves (The Ports and the Delta), and the most interesting agricultural areas and gastronomy in the region too. Combining cycling with visits to local attractions and cultural sites is made easy by the interconnectedness of all this in Terres de l'Ebre, and stays can be repeated or lengthened accordingly. In brief, a great variety of routes where the contrasts predominate and which allow to discover firsthand the most emblematic features of the area.




## ITINERARY 1 - The lagoon route

An ideal route for exploring the two main lagoons on the southern side of the Ebro Delta. Starting at the Casa de Fusta, the trail runs parallel along l'Encanyissada Lagoon and ends up in Poble Nou del Delta, where you can then decide to return by the same route or continue along the trail to the Tancada Lagoon.

**Not to be missed:** the observatories, Poble Nou del Delta, the traditional fishing arts and the salt works.






## ITINERARY 2 - Rivermouth / Ecomuseum

Starting at the Ecomuseum in Deltebre, the route winds alongside the riverbank to Riumar. You can visit the Ziggurat and Garxal Lagoons, the sand dunes at Riumar and the Vell Canal pond, all complimented with several observatories along the river. This route is especially recommended for Bird Watchers.

**Not to be missed:** the Ecomuseum, the Lagoons, the sand dunes at Riumar, the observatories and the wild Delta fauna.






## ITINERARY 3 - Fangar's Bay Ecomuseum

Ideal for discovering l'Ille de Mar port, the Rompent breakwater and Fangar Bay. During the tour, which starts at the Ecomuseum, typical Delta constructions can be seen, such as the traditional rustic huts and dwellings of the rice farmers and the shell fishermen's utensils.

**Not to be missed:** the Fondo river, the traditional fishing industry activities in the Fangar Bay and the ancient salt works of Secanella.






## ITINERARY 4 - L'Aldea / Camarles / L'Ampolla

A circular itinerary, connecting 3 Delta towns, starting and finishing at l'Aldea hermitage. During the journey you will pass by the defence towers of La Granadella and Camarles. Much of the route runs through a rocky area that separates the more rugged coastline from the flat plains of sedimentary soil in the Delta.

**Not to be missed:** the defence towers, Les Olles pond and the Delta landscapes.



## ITINERARY 5 - Riumar Family Itinerary

Discover the Ziggurat and the Garxal lagoons, the sand dunes at Riumar, the islands of Buda and San Antonio and the river mouth of the Ebro. There are several observatories especially designed for Bird Watching.

**Not to be missed:** the lagoons, the dunes of Riumar, the islands of Buda and San Antonio and the Delta's landscape full of birdlife.








## ITINERARY 6 - Amposta / Casa de Fusta

Beginning at the tourist information office in Amposta you will discover some of the most iconic landscapes of the Delta de l'Ebre. Apart from the typical rice fields, it is possible to visit the Ullals de Baltasar, the Encanyissada lagoon, the Casa de Fusta and contemplate the landscape from the observatories.

**Not to be missed:** the endemic fauna and flora of the Delta, the Encanyissa da lagoon, the Ullals springs and the views of the Montsià Mountain range.






## ITINERARY 7 - Sant Carles de la Ràpita / Casa de Fusta

This itinerary has two variants – from March to September one option and from April to October, the other. Both routes start in La Ràpita and take you to the Casa de Fusta, one of the most emblematic buildings of the Ebro Delta today, now housing an interpretation centre and an ornithological museum.

**Not to be missed:** the rice fields, the irrigation channels, the landscapes of the Delta and the Casa de Fusta.






## ITINERARY 8 - The Delta Towpath

The towpath is an ancient way linked to the river culture of the area. The bargemen used to send their flat bottom boats, filled mostly with sacks of rice but with other merchandise too, up river using just their own strength or pulled by their animals. It is a route of great beauty that crosses riverside woods, typical villages and ends up at the observatory the Alfacada.

**Not to be missed:** the riverside forests, the llagut boats and the islands of Gràcia and of Buda.








## ITINERARY 9 - Deltebre Waterfront route

A pleasant route along the banks of the river to Deltebre, with the island of Gràcia and Lo Passador bridge as references in the landscape. Without a doubt, one of the best views to be had of the Ebro river. On weekdays at 11:30am, the fish auction takes place at the Sant Joan Confraternity, just nearby the path.

**Not to be missed:** the Ebro river ferry crossings, the observatories and the Island of Gràcia.






## ITINERARY 10 - Les Olles pond route


A pathway following the edge of Fangar bay, offering a circular route around Les Olles pond, visits to the observatories hidden amongst the reeds and access across the wooden bridge at the deepest end of Les Olles. Discover as well, the pumping station of Les Olles and the birdlife of the Ebro Delta.

**Not to be missed:** Fangar Bay, Les Olles pond and the views from the observatories.






## 4 ITINERARIES IN TERRES DE L'EBRE

## ITINERARY 1 - La Galera Ravine


This advanced level route begins at the end of the Carroua ravine and follows the path leading up to its source at the Ports crest. It crosses areas of historical and natural interest and represents a very important biological corridor between the Ports and the Ebro River.

**Not to be missed:** the Galera and Solsó Ravines, the Sénia River and the views of the Ports Natural Park.






## ITINERARY 2 - Serra de Cardó circuit

A high level circular itinerary through the Serra de Cardó and Serra del Boix, allowing you to discover the natural surroundings, fauna and heritage elements in the form of old settlements, rock paintings or the Cardó medicinal springs. It offers incredible views over the Ebro valley and the Delta plains.

**Not to be missed:** the rock paintings of Cabrafeixet, the Cardó baths and the ancient medieval villages.



## ITINERARY 3 - Saint James' Way


The Ebro section of Saint James' Way brought together pilgrims travelling to Santiago de Compostela from the villages along the Mediterranean arch. It makes its way up from the Delta de l'Ebre into the Terra Alta, passing through Tortosa or Xerta and hidden villages and places of great natural beauty and tranquility.

**Not to be missed:** Tortosa, charming villages, the churches and sanctuaries.



## ITINERARY 4 - Up to Mount Caro


Leaving from the Ports Natural Park Headquarters in Roquetes, the route follows the road going up to Mont Caro. After crossing an area of dry land crops, you climb the steep Mediterranean facade of the Ports and continue until Cova Auellanes, one of the recreational areas of the Natural Park.

**Not to be missed:** the Ports Natural Park forests, Mont Caro and the lookouts over the Ebro Valley region.




## GREENWAY LA VAL DE ZAFÁN



The Greenway touristic cycling route is **135 km long** and follows the old railway line of the Val de Zafán, which used to link **Tortosa with Aragón**. Nowadays, the old train route has become a very popular bicycle route, ideal for everybody. From Tortosa, the Greenway joins the Tortosa-Aldea-Deltebre Nature Way that crosses the rice fields to the mouth of the Ebro River.

**Not to be missed:** the tunnels and bridges of the old railway line which winds through the valleys, ravines and the croplands along the way.


## THE EBRO NATURE TRAIL



This is the Catalan section of The Ebro Nature Trail. Beginning in Ebro Delta, it then borders the Ports Natural Park and ends in in Mequinensa, the Aragoness Township of the Franja de Ponent. It must be remembered that there are sections of this route that are not adapted to cyclists, such as the stretch from Barrufemes near Miravet.

**Not to be missed:** the City of Tortosa, the Miravet Castle, Sebes Reseve and the nature areas of l'Aiguabarreig de l'Ebre, Segre and Cinca.


## VIA AUGUSTA - EUROVELO 8, Terres de L'Ebre section



Within the Terres de l'Ebre region, together with the EuroVelo 8 route, stretches of the Via Augusta can still be found. This was the longest Roman road in Hispania with an approximate length of 1,500km running from the Pyrenees to Cádiz along the Mediterranean. The route skirts around the coastal mountains, crossing Tortosa and passing through Godall and Els Ports. Complete itinerary is still pending exact confirmation.

**Not to be missed:** Pla de la Galera, the Lledó ravine, the agricultural areas and the views.


## RECOMMENDATIONS

Several herds of extensively reared bulls graze in the Els Ports Protected Area. Beware, they can be dangerous.



Most of the Els Ports Protected Area is also a National Hunting Reserve. See the wild boar battue calendar on the Park's website.



**If you are mountain biking:**

- » Keep to the paths, don't ride cross-country.
- » Don't ride on trails with stone or wooden steps or on those expressly forbidden to bicycles.
